'Visual Thread'

Celebrating 37 years of Boyle Arts Festival, the magnificent setting of King House is yet again the centrepiece for the main exhibition.

As a gallerist it is such an honour to curate the 2026 exhibition 'Visual Thread' and also hard to believe that it is now 10 years (2016) since I first selected for the Boyle Arts Festival.

'Visual Thread' celebrates the richness and diversity of Irish art that has characterized the exhibition annually since 1989. The exhibition showcases over 150 artists drawn from across the Island of Ireland from West Cork to the Antrim Coast, with a concentration on painting, drawing, photography and sculpture. Sculpture is especially celebrated this year with the introduction of the Barry Feely Sculptor Award kindly sponsored by the Feelystone and the Feely Family.

An enormous debt of gratitude is owed to the artists for accepting my invitation and who make the annual exhibition so special.

Visual Thread will also include highly acclaimed international artists - Dame Barbara Rae RA (Edinburgh), Olivia Musgrave FRSS (London) and Hughie O'Donoghue RA (London).

2026 marked the sad passing of Dr Jamshid MirFenderesky (Fenderesky Gallery), a person who had such a significant input to this annual event, including the 2002 Boyle Arts Festival exhibition 'Artists from Ulster'

I hope my tenure selecting for the Boyle Arts Festival has maintained that legacy with a North/South flavour that has characterised the exhibition annually over the past 37 years.

'Visual Thread' demonstrates the quality and integrity of the visual arts in Ireland. As a gallerist my eye is always searching for work that has an honesty, an integrity, a visual presence, a Visual Thread.

BARRY FEELY SCULPTOR AWARD

The Feely Family is proud to partner with BAF to establish the Barry Feely Sculptor Award, honouring Barry's life, legacy and longtime contribution to the arts, following his passing in September 2025.

Barry was a founding member of BAF and played a pivotal role in the festival's growth and success. As both a dedicated committee member and Chairperson for many years, he helped shape the festival into a celebrated platform for the arts. His commitment to the arts, particularly the visual arts, also led to the establishment of the Boyle Civic Art Collection in 1990, alongside Fergus Ahern, creating a lasting cultural resource for the community. Barry was involved in many voluntary endeavours because of his love for Boyle.

A master craftsman in stone, Barry began his career at the age of 15 in the family business, Feely & Sons. Throughout his life, he championed and supported generations of sculptors, providing space, expertise and resources as the business expanded at its Greatmeadow premises. Today, Feelystone is led by Barry's sons, Finbarr and Shane Feely, continuing a remarkable family tradition that spans ten generations.

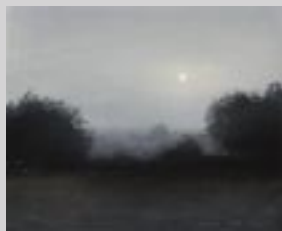
